Leaderships commitment	Shaping and reinforcing the safety culture within the organization

Demonstrating safety values	Leaderships commitment to continued safety practices helps emphasize the importance of a strong safety culture amongst employees

Continuing training i.e. toolbox talks, AHA,

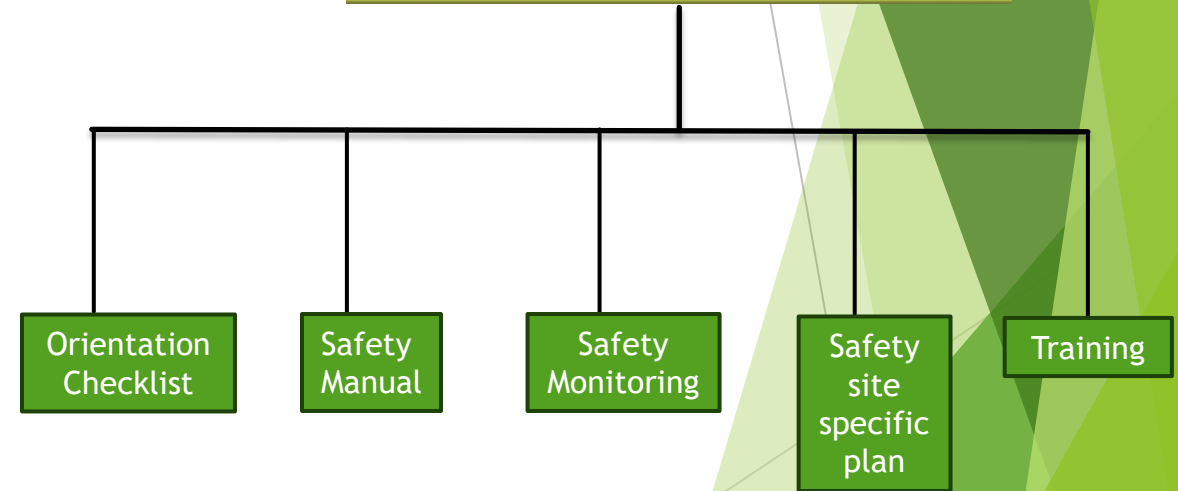
When employees are trained and certified it helps reduce workplace accidents and injuries

Signage posted around jobs serves as visual reminder of safety protocols and hazards

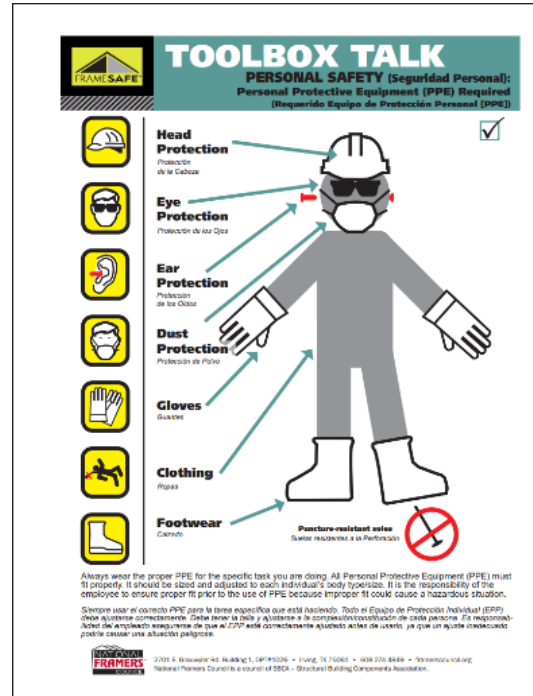
Sharing photos and videos of best practice and safety improvements helps build a strong safety culture.



Prevent workplace Illness & Injury



Safety glasses should be worn at all times during work hours to ensure your ability to see how to get home



By wearing your personal protective equipment during work hours, you can significantly reduce your risk of accidents



Wearing your hard hats during work hours helps prevent possible impact from falling objects and mitigating risk of serious head injuries.

Improve compliance in the workplace

General Job Safety	General safety rules on the job site help to protect you and your coworkers from harm and to prevent accidents.
Personal Safety	Personal safety practices are designed to ensure a safe and effective work environment and helps ensure that you and your coworker get to go home everyday.
Fall Protections	Falls are the leading cause of injuries and deaths on job sites, using your personal fall protective equipment helps to ensure the reduce risk of fatality and serious injury
Ladders	Propper ladder safety practices helps to minimize the preventions of fall and injuries from heights.
Guardrails	Guardrails are designed to provide a visual as well as a physical barrier around elevated conditions.
Rescue Plan	Rescue plans are an effective procedures that outlines communication and minimizes secondary risk in the event of a fall.

Having a safety Manual helps maintain a safe working environment by providing clear instructions and procedure for various tasks.



Toolbox Talks

Toolbox talk promotes safety awareness and helps reduce workplace injuries and ensure safety compliance.



Safety posters

Safety posters promote safety and reinforce messages and provide a constant reminder of safety protocols on site.



AHA (Activity Hazard Analysis)

Primary goal of AHA's is to enhance workplace safety by systematically identifying and controlling hazards associated with specific tasks.



NFC Newsletters

Safety Newsletters serve as a formal communication tool to address safety trainings, concerns, and a call to action for safety practices.
